

Terms & Conditions
Willard Public Library Renovation Raffle
2024

Promoter/Sponsor of this Friends of Willard Library. Half Pot Raffle (the “Raffle”) is Friends of Willard Library, Inc. with an address of 21 N First Avenue Evansville, IN 47710. All entrants agree to be bound by the terms and conditions provided in these Terms & Conditions as well as by all interpretations of these Terms & Conditions by Friends of Willard Library, Inc. and by all other decisions of Friends of Willard Library, Inc. including resolution of disputes in connection with this Raffle, which are final and binding in all matters relating to the Raffle. The Raffle is subject to all applicable Indiana laws and regulations, specifically, to the provisions of Indiana Code governing charity gaming, found at Indiana Code section 4-32.3, as well as to oversight by the Indiana Gaming Commission.

Eligibility

The Raffle is open to legal U.S. citizens who are at least 18 years of age or older at the time of entry. Active, Emeritus Members of the Friends Willard Library, and Willard Public Library employees shall not be eligible to enter or win.

Entry Period

Tickets will be on sale at the Willard Public Library, 21 N. First Avenue, Evansville, IN 47710 from April 8-June 8, 2024 during normal business hours.

Pop-up sale booths will be announced on Willard Public Library website and other outlets.

No tickets will sold after 5:30pm (CST) Friday June 7, 2024.

How to Enter

Tickets will be sold for the Raffle throughout the Entry Period. To enter the Raffle, entrant must purchase a Raffle ticket in person, no phone or online orders. Tickets may be purchased using CASH, DEBIT CARDS and/or CREDIT CARDS.

Raffle tickets will be sold as individual tickets for \$5.00 each.

Tickets can be purchased in person at the Willard Public Library during normal business hours and other venues that will be posted through the Willard Public Library.

All raffle ticket purchases must be completed by the end of the Entry Period to be eligible for the applicable drawing.

Prize Claim

All raffle ticket purchases are final, and no refunds or replacements will be issued.

In order to claim a prize the winner should call the following number (812-425-4309) or email the following email address (friendsofwillardlibrary@gmail.com) and provide contact information so a Friends of Willard Library representative can get back with them to make arrangements to meet with them at the Willard Public Library at 21 N. First Avenue Evansville, IN. The winning ticket and valid ID should be brought to that meeting and additional information on how to claim the prize will be provided. The winner must contact the Friends of Willard Library in the above-described manner within thirty (30) days of the end of the Entry Period, by close of business on Wednesday July 10, 2024 by 5:30pm (CST), in order to receive more information on how to claim the prize.

The holder of a winning ticket must provide Friends of Willard Library, Inc.. with all information required to claim a prize (including tax identification information). In the event:

- (i) that the winner does not contact Friends of Willard Library, Inc. within thirty (30) days of the end of the Entry Period (by close of business on Wednesday July 10, 2024 by 5:30pm (CST).);
- (ii) that the winner is ruled ineligible for any reason; or (iii) that the winner declines the prize, the prize will be forfeited and will be retained by Friends of Willard Library Inc. has no obligation to contact potential winners.

The Friends of Willard Library, Inc., its members, or any of its entities are not responsible for lost, interrupted or unavailable network, server or other connections, miscommunications, failed phone or computer hardware or software or telephone transmissions or technical failures, garbled or jumbled transmissions or other errors of any kind, whether human, mechanical or electronic; including without limitation the incorrect or inaccurate capture of winner information online, or for lost, late, incomplete, damaged, destroyed, delayed, stolen or misdirected winner information.

Winners will be required to sign a Declaration of Eligibility attesting to the fact that he/she is 18 years of age or older, as well as other terms and conditions as designated by Friends of Willard Library, Inc. and consent to the use of his/her likeness in order to collect the prize.

Prize Description

Each entrant who purchased a winning raffle ticket will receive one-half of the gross proceeds. The gross proceeds being the value of all monies collected from tickets purchased during the duration of the event. All remaining proceeds from the Raffle shall be retained by the Friends of Willard Library, Inc. to offset gaming expenses. The balance after deducting expenses shall be donated to a dedicated fund to be used for the preservation and repair of the Willard Public Library Building.

All prizes will be delivered via check within thirty (30) days of the winner delivering the winning raffle ticket, executed Declaration of Eligibility, and all other required documents to Friends of Willard Library Inc. For security and safety reasons, no cash payments will be made to the Raffle winners. Unclaimed winnings will be retained by Friends of Willard Library, Inc.

Persons who purchase a raffle ticket may NOT opt to give away their raffle ticket to other eligible persons, in doing so the purchaser and the transferee waives any claim he/she might otherwise have to the prize. Purchasers of any raffle tickets may not re-sell their raffle tickets to other parties and may not give a raffle ticket away to another person for the purpose of allowing that person to re-sell such raffle ticket. Any raffle ticket which has been resold in violation of these Terms & Conditions shall be void. All individuals who re-sell, purchase, or receive a raffle ticket in violation of these Terms & Conditions shall be ineligible to participate in the Raffle or to win a prize. A winner may transfer his/her prize to a third party provided that the following conditions are met:

- (a) the transferee would have otherwise been eligible to enter the Raffle.
- (b) the transferee shall be responsible for all taxes and costs described in these Terms & Conditions.
- (c) the transferee shall be bound by all Terms and Conditions that are applicable to the winner.

Raffle Cancellation, Suspension or Modification

Friends of Willard Library, Inc. reserves the right to cancel, modify or suspend the Raffle and/or change dates relating to the promotion in case of schedule changes, acts of God, force majeure events, computer viruses, bugs, corruption or unfairness of the security or administration of the Raffle, or for any other reason at the sole discretion of the Friends of Willard Library, Inc.
